Web Quality for Culture. Heritage online for research, learning, and cultural tourism" is the theme of the European onference to be held in **Parma** in the **Paganini auditorium (viale Barilla, 5) on the 20th and 21st of November** in the ambit of events for the Italian Presidency of the Council of Europe (1 July – 31 December 2003).

he meeting is organised under the high patronage of the Presidenza della Repubblica Italiana in the ambit of the IINERVA project (Ministerial Network for Valorising Activities in Digitisation), a community project to create a oordinating mechanism for digitisation policies and programmes of cultural heritage among European ountries. It is a mission in which The Directorate general for the Information Society of the European Commission, the ational Representatives' Group for digitisation (NRG) and the Ministero per i Beni e le Attività Culturali italiano (Italian linistry of Culture), as MINERVA project coordinator, are particularly involved.

nternational experts will participate at the event. They will trace the outlook for future technological developments for safeguarding and valorizing cultural heritage.

n this occasion will be presented:

The **Manual for the quality of culture websites**, drawn up by MINERVA European workgroup that was esponsible for researching and proposing methods and quality criteria for a cultural web application. It proposes methods nd criteria aimed at achieving content quality, elaborated and proposed by modern information and communication echnologies (ICT) and specific cultural website on-line information services, taking into account, in particular, the needs of ne disabled -which is a pre-condition to guaranteeing an information society that is open to all;

The **Charter of Parma**, which, while setting down the principles and main recommendations established by the lanual, proposes an adequate diffusion throughout the member States of the European Union and candidate states.
