

# AIB-WEB, the Web site of the Italian Library Association: a site by librarians for librarians and all users.



## AIB-WEB

AIB-WEB is the whole set of World Wide Web pages maintained directly on the Internet by the national AIB (Italian Library Association) and its territorial branches (regional sections) and non-territorial ones (commissions, groups, central bodies) to promote knowledge of AIB activities, of all is professionally important for Italian librarians and to offer services to librarians and all users. All sections of the site are regularly updated by the editorial team.



## Documentazione di fonte pubblica (DFP) Public Bodies Documentation

DFP is a guide to sources and documents produced by public bodies. Specific attention is devoted to Italian legal information. The aim of the index is to help librarians in retrieving Italian public sector information available on the Net.



## Repertorio della formazione professionale Index to professional education and training

It gives information on professional education and training offer both in public and private sectors for librarians, archivists and information specialists, mainly by linking to specific documentation released by the organizing institutions on the Internet.



## La biblioteca dell'AIB AIB Library

The library, opened in 1961, is specialized in library, bibliographic and information sciences. It holds 7.700 volumes, 460 periodicals of which 117 are current, and a collection of grey literature. It offers a bibliographic information service, and photocopy service. Loan is reserved to AIB members. The library offers pay document delivery and interlibrary loan services.



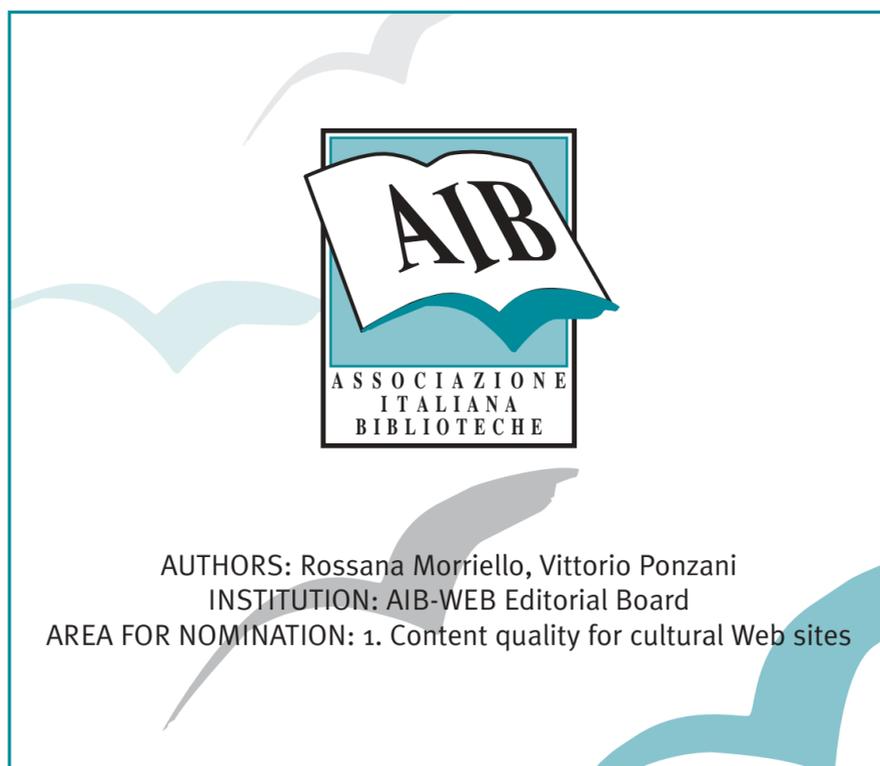
## SegnaWeb

It is an information service tailored on user's needs, managed by AIB and CILEA, and realized with the software MyLibrary. It is a co-operative service to which librarians from public libraries all over Italy are working, to select and catalogue quality Internet resources. The aim is to offer an online quick reference service.



## MetaOPAC Azalai Italiano (MAI)

MAI is a database realized in co-operation by AIB and CILEA. It includes 645 OPAC recorded and catalogued by a staff of librarians and computer specialists. MAI offers a service of simultaneous MetaSearch in 184 OPACs (their number is constantly growing) through three interfaces for MetaSearching: 1. global in all OPACs; 2. by region; 3. with use of filters (type of material, geographical areas, type of libraries). The interface for filter MetaSearch is reproduced here.
